

1. **a. Call to Order** - The meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m. by Village President Paul Schore.

b. Roll Call - Village Clerk Brian Simeur called roll with the following Trustees present: Trustee Gary Residori, Trustee Vera Amiano, Trustee Bruce Greenlee and Trustee Wayne Baranowski. Also in attendance were Village Administrator Gregg Spathis, Village Treasurer Ron Riebe and Village Attorney Patrick Dunn. Absent were Trustee Scott Byrne and Trustee Rick Fischer.
2. **Sign in sheet** - Mayor Schore asked everyone in attendance to be sure to sign the sign in sheet.
3. **Mayor's Explanation of Need for Project** - Mayor Schore asked Neil Piggush from Tyson Engineering (the village engineer) to give an overview of the project. Mr. Piggush said that a new pedestrian bridge over Route 45 at the intersection of Route 102 would be constructed. Mayor Schore said that this will make a very unsafe intersection a lot safer, especially for the Olivet Nazarene University student that cross there. The resolution that is on the agenda tonight would allow for the Village to submit the application for a grant.
4. **Public Comments:** Trustee Greenlee asked if this would handle bike traffic. Mr. Piggush said it would. Trustee Baranowski asked what the span of the bridge would be. Mr. Piggush said it would be between 100 to 120 feet and would allow for clear sight lines for vehicle traffic.

5. **Adjournment** - A motion was made by Trustee Residori and seconded by Trustee Greenlee to adjourn the Public Hearing. Motion passed on a voice vote of 4-0. The Public Hearing was adjourned at 5:49 p.m.
