Public Hearing before the Corporate Authorities

October 10, 2012 at 5:30 p.m.

Call to Order - Village President Paul Schore called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

- 1. Roll Call** - Village Attorney Pat Dunn called roll with the following Trustees present: Trustee Gary Residori, Trustee Bruce Greenlee, Trustee Scott Byrne, and Trustee Rick Fischer. Also in attendance were Village Administrator Gregg Spathis, Village Attorney Pat Dunn and Village Treasurer Ron Riebe. Absent were Trustee Vera Amiano, Trustee Wayne Baranowski and Village Clerk Brian Simeur.
- 2. Residential Aggregation For Electric Rates** -
 - Mayor Schore briefly explained process.
 - David Hoover from NIMEC presented a visual presentation stating how the program works and gave an overview of deregulation. Currently, Exelon supplies energy to ComEd but so can 40 some other companies. Com Ed would be the contact if there is an outage (they own the lines) and will still act as the billing agency.
 - The State of Illinois wanted deregulation to happen more quickly so they came up with municipal aggregation. Residents may opt out. Approximately 300 municipalities have done this so far and their residents are saving between 25% - 40%.
- 3. Public Comments**- None.
- 4. Adjournment** - A motion was made by Trustee Residori, seconded by Trustee Byrne, to adjourn the Public Hearing. Motion passed on a voice vote of 4-0. The Public Hearing was adjourned at 5:51 p.m.
