1. **Call to Order** - The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Village President Paul Schore.
2. **Roll Call** - Village Clerk Brian Simeur called roll with the following Trustees present: Trustee Gary Residori, Trustee Vera Amiano, Trustee Bruce Greenlee, Trustee Wayne Baranowski and Trustee Rick Fischer. Also in attendance were Village Administrator Gregg Spathis, Village Treasurer Ron Riebe and Village Attorney Patrick Dunn. Absent was Trustee Scott Byrne.
3. **Public Hearing - Ordinance (13-1934) (An Ordinance Authorizing The Issuance And Sale By The Village of Bourbonnais, Kankakee County, Illinois Of Not To Exceed \$20,000,000 Industrial Project Revenue Bonds (Olivet Nazarene University Project))**
  - a. Doug Perry Representing Olivet Nazarene University explained what the \$20 million will be used for and that there will be no risk to the Village of Bourbonnais, the village is merely a conduit for Olivet Nazarene University. Mayor Schore noted that this is the 4<sup>th</sup> such bond deal that Village of Bourbonnais has been involved with and this it is required by state law that the village approves such an ordinance.

Trustee Residori said everything that Olivet Nazarene University does is first class.
4. **Public Comments:** None.

5. **Adjournment** - A motion was made by Trustee Residori, seconded by Trustee Fischer, to adjourn the Public Hearing. Motion passed on a voice vote of 5-0. The Public Hearing was adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
