


Demographics

Founded by French Canadians and North American Indians, today the Village of Bourbonnais continues to have a richly diverse population base (though not yet as diverse as Illinois or the U.S.)


With Olivet Nazarene University located in Bourbonnais, the percentage of college graduates among the Village's adult population is 26.8%, similar to the United States' 29.3%. Bourbonnais' poverty rate is lower than the county, state, or nation.

During the first decade of the 21st Century, Bourbonnais's population grew by 22%, much faster than Kankakee County, Illinois, or the U.S. The Village has continued to grow since 2010, a trend that will likely continue with the addition of a new interchange on the north edge of the community.


Percent Persons in Poverty, 2014




Percent Population Change 2000 - 2010

College Degree Percent over 25 Years of Age




Housing

The Village of Bourbonnais is the choice community of Kankakee County for residential development, with a median home value of \$173,100, higher than the rest of the county and on par with the rest of Illinois and the U.S.


67.4% of Bourbonnais' housing units are owner-occupied, a higher percentage than Illinois or the U.S.

At 2.3%, the Village of Bourbonnais has seen the highest increase in home values from 2015 to 2016 relative to surrounding communities¹, and home values are projected to rise an additional 3.5% from 2016-2017.


Median Home Value 2010 - 2014




Owner-occupied Housing Units by Percent 2010 - 2014

Retail Sales

The Village of Bourbonnais' Median Household Income of \$63,707 is the highest in Kankakee County and exceeds the Median Household Income of both Illinois and the U.S. by more than \$5,000.


Bourbonnais is a very attractive community for retailers, with total retail sales per capita of \$31,222, far outpacing the county, state, and nation. This illustrates how strongly Bourbonnais attracts retail shoppers from the surrounding region.

Similarly, Bourbonnais' total accommodation and food services sales per capita of \$3,117 per person easily exceeds that of the county, state, and nation.


Finally, healthcare and social service revenues per capita are higher in Bourbonnais than in Kankakee County, Illinois, or the U.S.

Bourbonnais is primed for continued commercial development, with the pending interchange on the north edge of the community just an hour south of Downtown Chicago and an hour north of the University of Illinois' main campus in Champaign-Urbana.


Median Household Income | 2014




Retail Sales per Capita | 2012
