Starting Salary: \$63,356 (beginning base salary not counting additional compensation listed below)

Sworn Police Officers: 27 Full-time

All applicants must meet the following minimum requirements established by the Village of Bourbonnais Fire & Police Commission:

- U.S. citizenship;
- No felony convictions (or any misdemeanor conviction involving moral turpitude as specified in Illinois Statute 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-6);
- Must possess a valid Illinois driver's license;
- Must be at least 21 years of age and under the age of 35 at the time of application (unless otherwise exempt by Illinois Compiled Statutes 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-6);
- Must reside within 30 miles of the village limits within the one (1) year probationary period;
- High school diploma or GED equivalent;
- Associates Degree - OR - at least 64 credit hours from an accredited college or university (unless otherwise exempt by Illinois Compiled Statutes 65 ILCS 5/10 2.1-6);
- Valid POWER card issued within one (1) year of application deadline (waived for Certified Law Officers);
- This application process is limited to the first 100 applications submitted -OR- the deadline date of June 14, 2024, whichever occurs first.
- **Application Deadline:** Friday, June 14, 2024, at 4:00 PM (CST).

Additional Compensation
