Vera Amiano's Garden Guidelines

The following guidelines have been established by the Village of Bourbonnais for Vera Amiano's Garden within Jordan Park located at 59 Jordan Dr. Please read the guidelines and direct any questions or comments to Nicole Meredith at 815-802-5365 or meredithn@villageofbourbonnais.com

1. All gardeners are required to complete an application form. A plot fee of \$10.00 is due.
2. No perennials are allowed in the plot. The gardeners are not guaranteed a plot or the same plot every year. If you have questions about whether a plant is allowed, please ask before planting.
3. Keep your plot and the adjoining pathways tended. If your plot appears to be untended for a period and you haven't contacted Nicole Meredith, you will be contacted, and your plot may be assigned to another gardener. Call Nicole Meredith if you need help or if you will be out of town for an extended period.
 - If you plan to discontinue the use of your plot, please let Nicole Meredith know as soon as possible so that your plot can be assigned to another gardener.
4. Tall plants and vines should be planted in places where they will not interfere with your surrounding gardeners' plots.
5. Planting illegal plants is prohibited.
6. Please put weeds and dead plants in the garbage bin provided, do not leave them in the pathway.
7. Do not pick or apply anything from another person's plot without their approval.
8. Pick up litter when you see it to keep the garden clean!
9. Smoking, drugs, and alcohol are not allowed.
10. Please supervise pets and children in the garden.
11. At the end of the gardening season, all dead plants and non-plant materials (string, wood, metal, plastic, etc.) must be removed and disposed of properly.
 - Please have your garden clean by November 1
12. Report theft, vandalism, and unusual activities to the Bourbonnais Police Department non-emergency number at 815-937-3579.
13. Use common courtesy, be considerate of your gardening neighbors, and ENJOY!

If any of the guidelines are violated, you will be contacted by phone or email and have one week to address the violation. After one week, if the violation has not been remedied, you may lose your gardening privileges.
