General Permit Procedures

- 1. Complete permit application
- 2. Attach Plat of Survey to application
- 3. Attach set of drawings to application, if applicable

Detached Garage Requirements


- 1. One detached garage/building is allowed.
- 2. An accessory garage/building cannot be established prior to the principal use.
- 3. The maximum size of a detached garage is (624 sqft) square feet.
- 4. The maximum height of the door shall be eight (8') feet. The maximum height of the building from grade to the peak shall not exceed (15') feet.
- 5. All detached garages must have driveway access from a public right-of-way.
 - 1. Maximum driveway widths for garages:
 - 1. One car garage (12') feet
 - 2. Two-car garage (26') feet
 - 3. Three-car garage (32') feet
- 2. The driveway pad, shown as (Y) on the page 2 diagram, shall be a maximum width of (24') feet from the front of the garage doors.

Sheds/Utility Building Requirements

1. The maximum height of the building from grade to the peak shall be (14') feet.

STREET

- 2. The maximum size of the building shall not exceed (200 sqft) square feet.
- 3. All sheds/utility buildings may be placed either on skids or a paved surface. In all cases, the building must be anchored to the ground to withstand 100 MPH wind gusts. Please consult with a building official concerning proper anchoring.



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Location of Accessory Buildings

- 1. Accessory buildings are allowed in the rear yard.
- 2. Buildings must be at least one (1') foot away from any easement.
- 3. Accessory buildings shall be a minimum of ten (10') feet from any other building.
- 4. Buildings shall be setback five (5') feet from any read or interior side lot line.
- 5. If the side property line abuts a street, the minimum distance the accessory buildings can be from the property line is the front setback requirement in the zoning district for which it is located.
- All construction shall follow the Village of Bourbonnais Building Codes.
- It is the owners' responsibility to contact J.U.L.I.E. at 1-800-892-0123 for location of all utilities.
- No construction may begin until a building permit has been approved and issued. The owner of the property is responsible to ensure a permit has been issued prior to construction beginning. The permit placard must be placed on the front of the principal structure so it can be seen from the public right-of-way at all times during construction.
