## **2019 BOURBONNAIS POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNUAL REPORT INTRODUCTION “The Year of Projects”**

On behalf of the members of the Bourbonnais Police Department, I am pleased to present the 2019 Bourbonnais Police Department Annual Report. This past year we undertook several major projects that will facilitate our pursuit of department accreditation for the first time in our department's history in 2020. Those projects included; records reduction, evidence reduction, implementation of a scan/barcoding inventory system for evidence, and a continuation of the updating of every department policy. Despite the extra projects and additional training mandates, our officers continued to participate in numerous community events throughout the year solidifying our emphasis to community policing. Our police department remains committed and focused on providing the residents and visitors of Bourbonnais with the very best police services we can provide, delivered in a professional and efficient manner.

We are grateful for the support of our community and I would like to personally thank the many individuals, families, businesses, churches and community groups that blessed us throughout the year with outpourings of thanks and appreciation! Your support of our officers and department help to sustain us more than you can ever know. I would also like to thank Mayor Schore, our entire Village Board, Department Heads in every division and all village support staff and workers, as it truly takes the cooperation and support of every team member for us to succeed in our mission of making Bourbonnais the most sought-after community in which to raise a family in Illinois. I also want to extend my gratitude to our Police Commissioners, Bruce Dickstein, Tim Milner and Brad Thomas, who volunteered numerous hours this past year testing and interviewing officers for entry level and promotional eligibility lists. 2019 proved to be a very busy year for us as we continued to not only meet, but exceed the state mandated training requirements for every officer, all while providing exceptional service to our community. Our officers were involved in many community events and provided many hours of instruction on diverse topics to organizations in our community during the year. We also had increased participation in the IDOT funded traffic safety campaigns which were










## 2019 Traffic Stops by Month




### 2019 Cad/Call/Activity Volume by Month




## Number of Incidents between 1-10 calls


# Number of Incidents between 11 and 100 calls




# Number of Incidents between 101 and 500 calls




# Incident Types over 501 calls




# 2019 Incidents by hour for each day of the week










### Total Incidents by Hour in 2019
