### **“The Year of the Pandemic”**

On behalf of the members of the Bourbonnais Police Department, I am pleased to present the 2020 Bourbonnais Police Department Annual Report. We had very high expectations this year of pursuing several projects, however we never anticipated that a world-wide pandemic, known as “covid-19” would hit us and the devastating effects that it would have throughout the year on our officers and our operations. While we pride ourselves on planning, no one could anticipate widescale shutdowns of government, businesses, and schools and the difficulty of staffing the department 24/7 with nearly 50% of our department being struck with Covid during the year. I am grateful that due to proper planning, we had adequate supplies of PPE to protect our staff as much as possible. I am also grateful to our courageous medical professionals and all first responders who went above and beyond to keep all of us safe while jeopardizing their own health in the process. You are true heroes!

Despite the pandemic, our officers were on duty working to safeguard the members of our community 24/7, although they looked different as they were wearing masks and at times, eye protection and gloves. Although we were unable to participate in the vast array of community events that we always are involved with, we still were able to do some that weren't cancelled due to covid-19.

On a brighter note, we celebrated several milestones in 2020, including the following anniversaries for some of our officers. Police Services Coordinator Todd Peters celebrated 25 years with the Village, Patrol Commander Brent Barrie 20 years, Sergeant Joe Bertrand 15 years, Patrolman Adam Mitchell 15 years and Patrolman Ignacio Czako 5 years. We thank them for their service and dedication to our community! In other news, Patrolman/Agent Tim Banks successfully completed canine training school despite the covid-19 restrictions and Sergeant Craig King completed Northwestern Universities 400 hour School of Police Staff and Command.

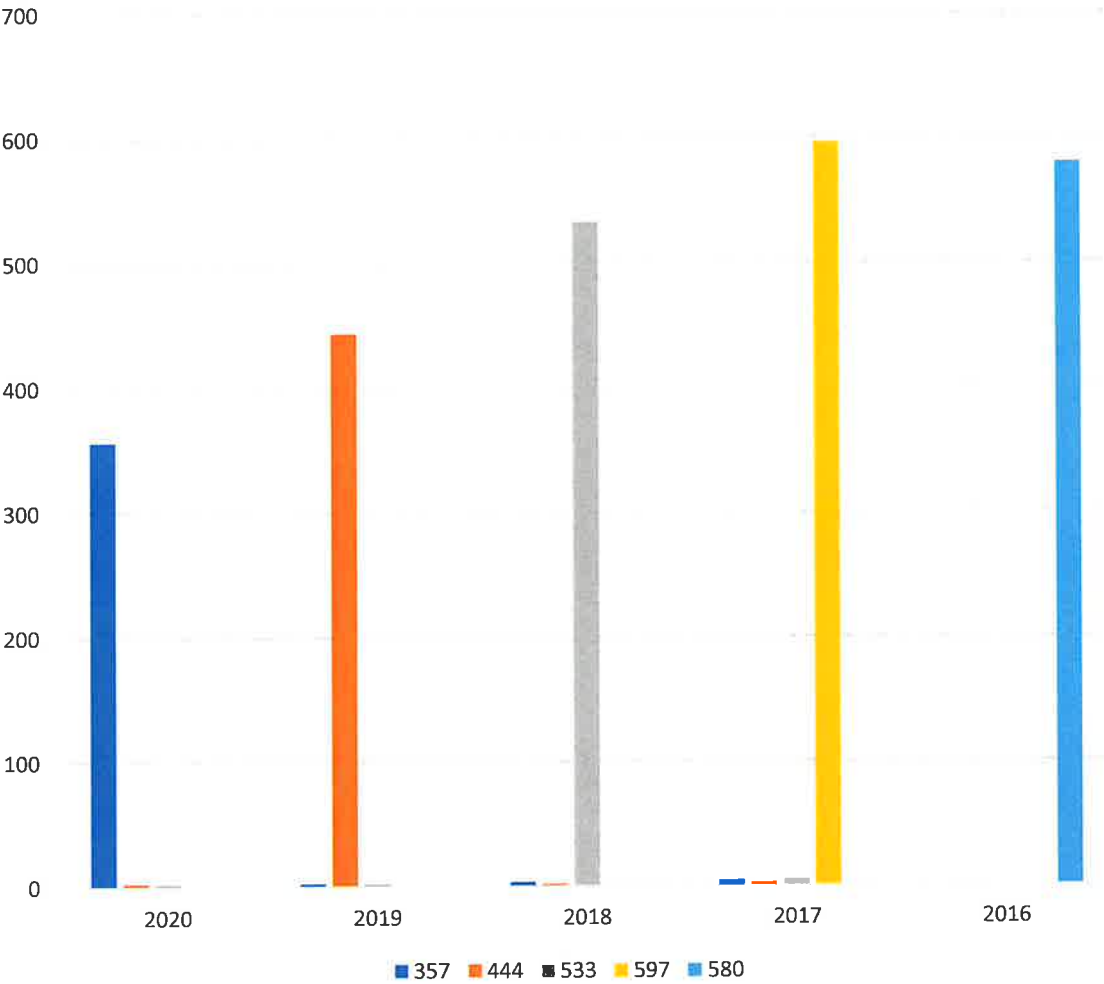

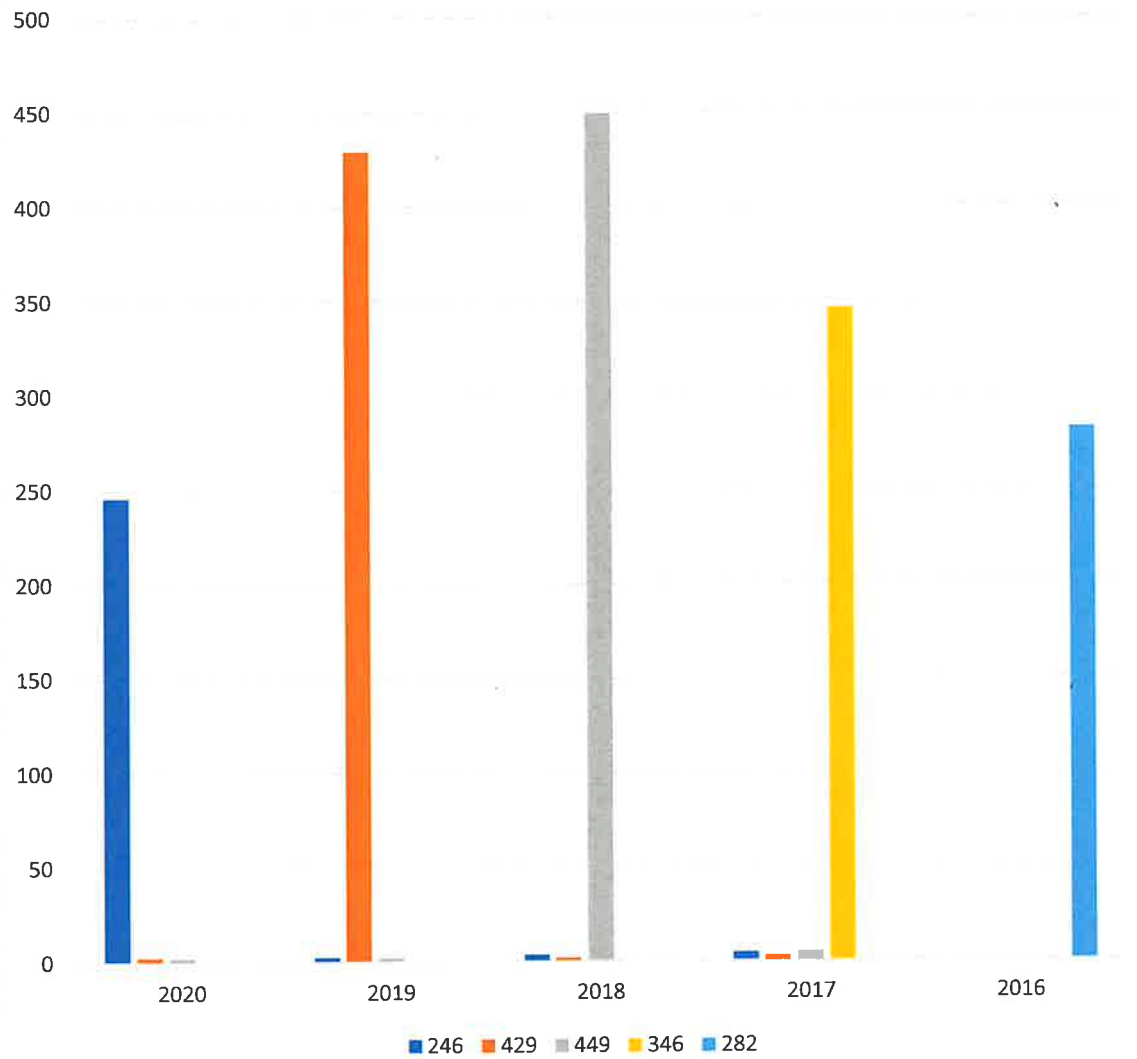

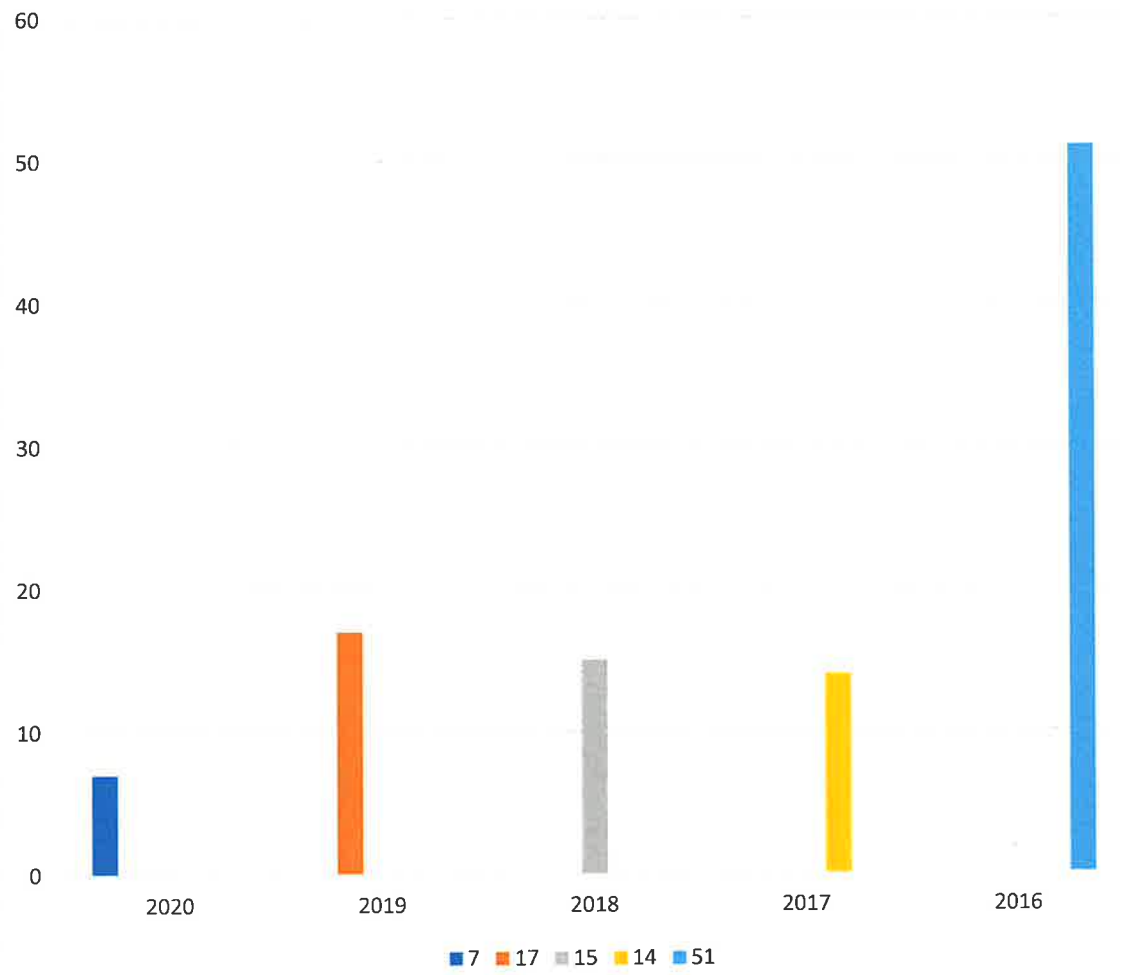
Accident Comparison Chart



Adult Arrests Comparison Chart

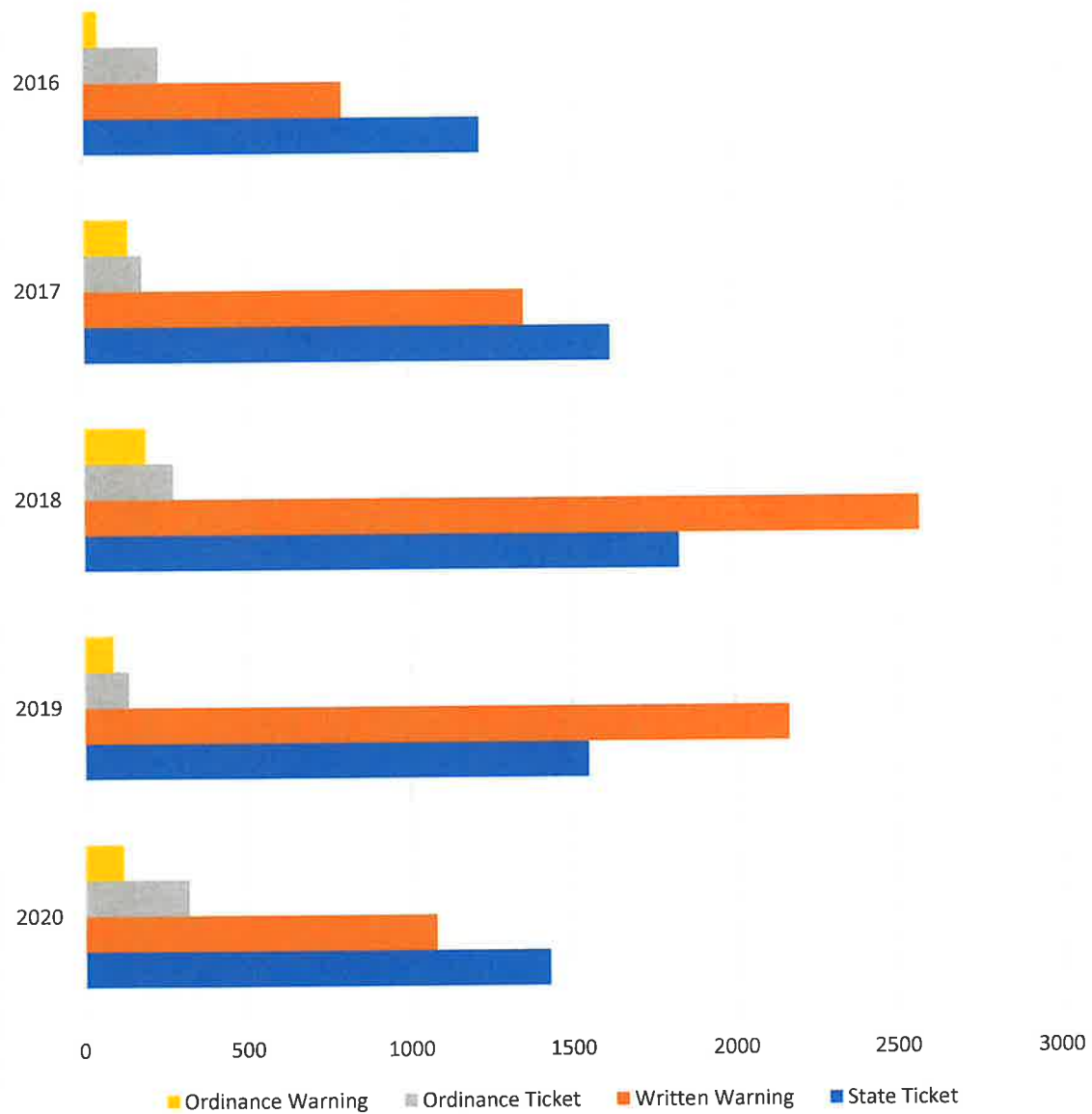


Juvenile Arrests Comparison Chart

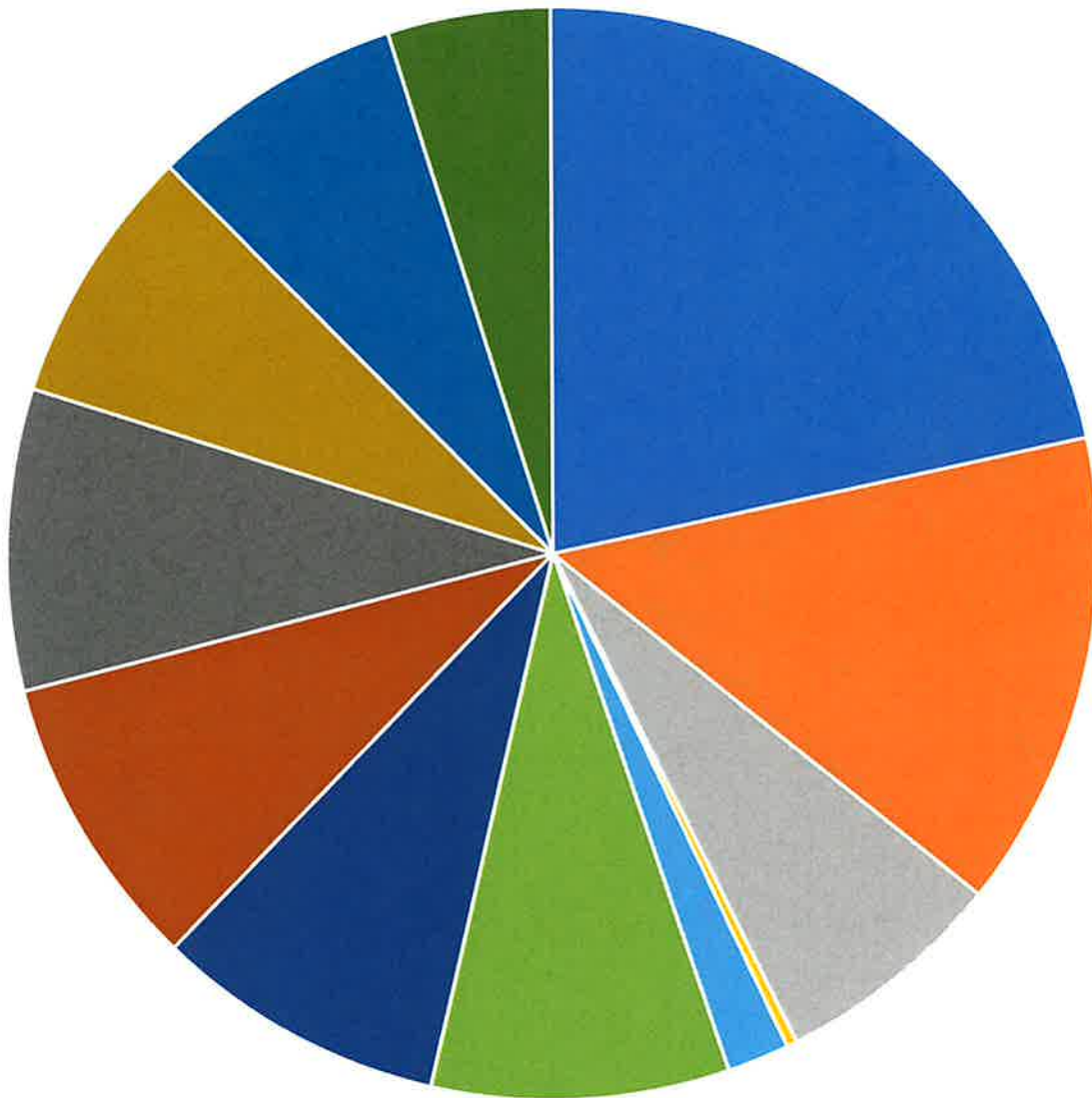




## Ticket/Warning Comparisons

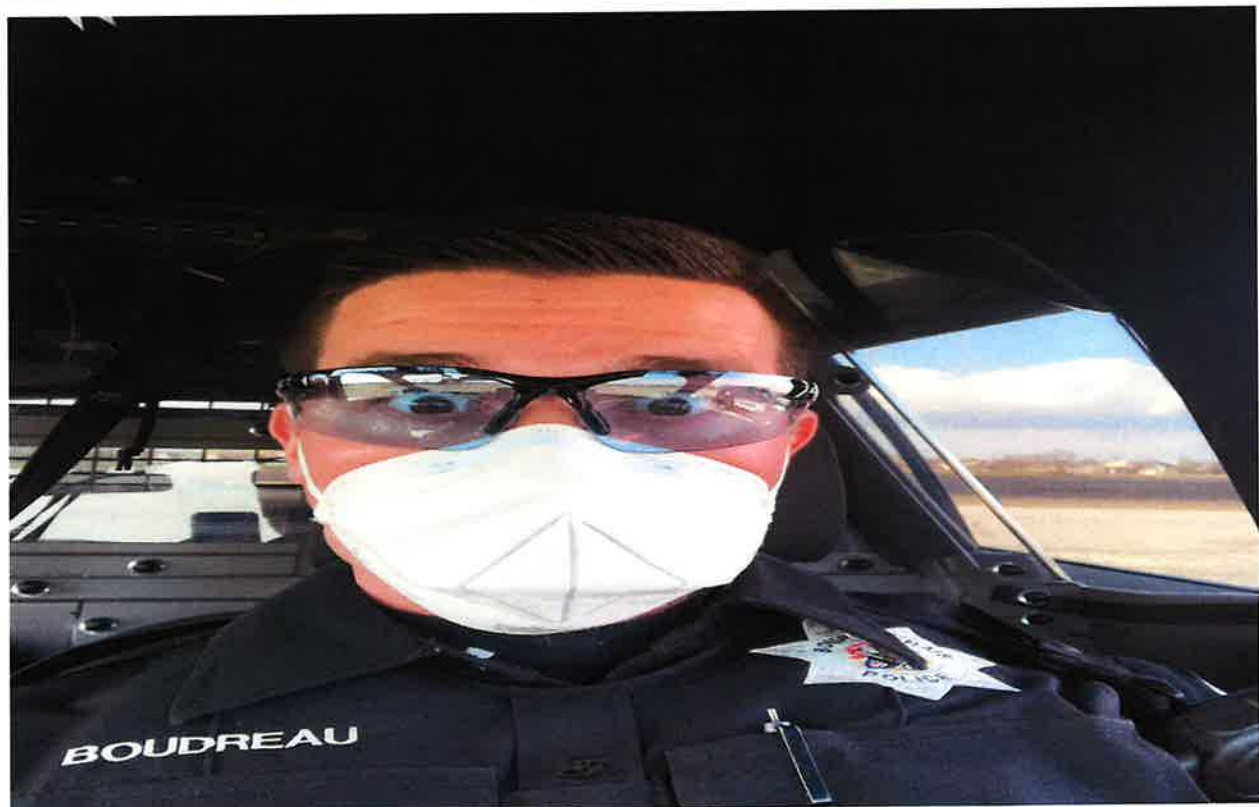
