

# FOOD TRUCKS AND CARTS

## PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES

Food trucks and carts are large vehicles equipped with facilities for cooking and selling food.

- ❖ Hours of Operation: 7:00 AM – 10:00 PM
- ❖ Permitted in: B-1, B-2, U-1, I, M-1, and M-2 Zoning Districts.
- ❖ Spatial relationships with established restaurants and other food vendors: Location requirements. The use shall be located at least: 150 feet from any existing restaurant, unless approved by the zoning administrator, or consent from all restaurant owners within 150 feet is provided.
- ❖ Provide copy of documentation confirming private property owner's permission.
- ❖ All mobile food vendor must have accompanied a license from the Kankakee County Health Department.
- ❖ Operations shall not set-up within any designated sight triangle/vehicle clear zone.
- ❖ Operations shall not impede safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic, parking lot circulation or access to any public alley or sidewalk.
- ❖ Operations shall not place signs/banners in or alongside the public right-of-way or across roadways. Signs must be permanently affixed to or painted on the mobile food vehicle or mobile vending cart, or in the case of a mobile retail food establishment, attached directly to the table, awning, canopy or similar item upon or under which sales are directly made.
- ❖ Selling anything other than food and non-alcoholic beverages unless a special event liquor license is approved by the village.
- ❖ No amplified music or loudspeakers shall be permitted. The operations shall always comply with the provisions of the village's noise ordinance
- ❖ Mobile retail food vendors shall not remain in one location for a period of one consecutive day or longer without permission from the zoning administrator.
- ❖ Mobile food vendors are not permitted on public street, public property or sidewalks in the village without permission from the zoning administrator.

**The violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00. Each day any violation of this section shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.**
